All three Supervisors in attendance: Tom Stull, Jr., Henry Hoffer, Dan Pribisco, and Sec. Trudy Harkcom
Tom brought meeting to order

Motion by Dan to approve last month's meeting minutes, Henry sec, all agreed

Motion by Tom to approve payment of bills, Dan sec., all agreed

Public in attendance: Robert Nicodemus, Vicki Snyder, Holly Webster and Kerri Schott

Public Comment Period: none

New Business: Tom motion to change the current hospitalization policy to a Health Reimbursement Account policy...will be a savings to township of \$5,000 per year. Henry sec., all agreed

Tom motion to have the twp solicitor do a driveway ordinance to help the problem of residents pushing snow from their driveway's onto the township roads. Dan sec., all agreed

Tom motion to send letter of support to the township legislators asking for the state, county, etc. to leave the local real estate tax collector's alone and not take their duties from them. Henry sec, all agreed.

Dan motion to contact local banks, etc. to ask about interest rates for township investments. Tom seconded, all agreed

Dan motion to sign and approve the Dirt and Gravel road project for Skyview road, Tom seconded, all agreed.

Tom mentioned the CoStars Salt Contract for the 2011-2012 winter season for Donegal Township...at a 150 tons of salt..township will legally have to purchase at least 60% of stated needs....but can purchase up to 140% of required amount.

Tom motion to purchase the Emergency Management Book, dealing with topics on Emergency Management in 6 different books at \$47 per book....total cost of \$278.00, and ask Donegal Borough to help with cost also...Dan sec., all agreed

Tom motion to advertise for road materials for the 2011 year, will open bids at a special meeting on March 22, 2011 to open all bids received. Dan seconded, all agreed

Old Business: Township received the Asset Auction check for township equipment sold..\$39,904.20..1/24/2011.

Township contacted Virginia Stump of the US Rural Development program on the status of the grant application the township submitted last July on a 35% grant for the purchase of a mini-excavator...she stated that there is no word and with the budget talks does not know if any money will be available.
