

Donegal Township Meeting Minutes
January 3, 2011
Regular Monthly Meeting
5:00pm

All three Supervisors in attendance: Tom Stull, Jr., Henry Hoffer, Dan Pribisco, and Sec. Trudy Harkcom
Tom brought meeting to order
Henry motion to approve last month's meeting minutes, Dan seconded, all agreed
Dan motion to pay bills, Tom seconded, all agreed.

Public in attendance: Kerri Schott, Robert Nicodemus and Robert King

Public Comment Period: Kerri Schott asked supervisors to not plow Camp Run Road bare on Rte. 381 end of road.....Tom answered that township plows do not plow the road bare....if road is baring off, it is due to the sun helping the salt to work in melting the snow off.

New Business: Robert King addressed the board of Supervisors on the property the township owns at the former Emerick property located on Rte. 31 at intersection of Rte. 711 N....Mr. King asked what the supervisors plans are for the property and future installation of a traffic light at entrance of property, by lining up the driveway from the Champion Christian school with intersection?...Mr. King stated that he has a developer interested in property he owns farther back from intersection and they have problem with how the intersection is now by not being lined up with Rte 711N and no light...he stated that he knows the twp has an agreement with the Mountain Laurel Chamber of Commerce for installing a welcome to the Laurel Highlands sign on township property, which he would work with township on placing the sign on property and still lining up the intersection for a traffic light...Mr. King asked township what the expense would be for a traffic light and landscaping on township property, that he could give to his developer. Tom stated that the supervisors will talk with Twp solicitor, Penn-dot about the restrictions set by DEP on use of property. Henry motion to set up meeting with solicitor and Penn-dot to discuss Mr. Kings plans...Dan seconded, all agreed.

Tom motion to approve Resolution # 2011-3 setting the IRS millage rate for 2011 at .51 cents for private vehicle use reimbursement. Henry seconded, all agreed.

Tom motion to approve Resolution # 2011-2, allowing Commercial Motor Vehicles to be exempt in case of emergencies from daily driving limits set forth by Penn-Dot. Dan seconded, all agreed.

Old Business: Tom stated that the township bought a car port for material storage and it will be arriving on Saturday to be assembled.

Tom stated that the township received around \$40,000 from the Asset Auction of township equipment no longer used by township.

Supervisors stated that they will meet with Rob Cronauer from the Conservation District to discuss a Dirt and Gravel road project for Donegal Township for this round of funding, also will meet with the Dept of Forestry to discuss plowing off of Camp Run Road on an abandoned section of road. Motion for adjournment by Henry, seconded by Tom, all agreed.
