Meeting Minutes from the

May 13, 2024 Regular Monthly Meeting

All Three Supervisors in attendance: Tom Stull, Jr., Dan Pribisco, Jay Siesky and twp. secretary Trudy Harkcom

Meeting opened with Pledge of Allegiance

Motion by Dan to approve last month's meeting minutes, Jay seconded, all agreed.

Motion by Jay to pay bills, Dan seconded, all agreed

Public in attendance: Ray Keener, Marilee Pletcher, John Cenkner, Cameron Bobnar and Dan Hewitt (solicitor)

Public Comment Period: Ray Keener stated that K2 engineering (Township's 3rd party building inspector) is holding up the finishing of the repairs being done to the Stahlstown Church due to the handicapped ramp going into the church is not the correct size, and needs to be changed to be ADA compliant thru the Labor & Industry Building Codes. Dan Hewitt stated that the township can only refer them to the Appeals Board for any variance to the building code requirements. Township has an appeal board thru the Indiana/Westmoreland COG. Dan stated that the township will give the information to them to contact the Appeals Board for their request and concerns.

A borough resident asked about the Borough agreement to the township to be a part of the public sewage project. Dan stated that he has spoken to the Borough Solicitor and also Mr. Kessler at DEP. At this time the agreement does not fulfill the Township's ability to agree to. Mr. Gary Leister from The EADS Group who is the head engineering company on the sewage project did put together a number for the Borough's costs, as the sewage plant can accommodate the Borough. Mr. Liester will forward this onto the township solicitor.

No other public comment

New Business: Discussion on Solar Farms being constructed in the township. Dan suggested that an agreement with solar farm owner be in place, also a Bond to be given to township. Look at an Ordinance to help regulate the size of farm and also for de-commissioning costs when replacing. Township supervisors will discuss more at next meeting in June.

Motion by Dan to authorize Thomas A. Stull, Jr. to sign all documents for the ECMS System for new Bridge Reimbursement Agreement with Penn-Dot for next 5 years. Jay seconded, all agreed.
