Meeting Brought to Order

Pledge of Allegiance

Supervisors Dan Pribisco, Jay Siesky, and Christopher Younkin and Township Secretary Keith White in attendance

Public in Attendance: Andy Fedorko, EADS Group; Taylor Robbins, Mountain Watershed Association; Linda Brown, Linda Brown's Floral; Jason McGiniss

Christopher Younkin made a motion to approve the minutes of the March meeting. Jay Siesky seconded, and the motion carried.

Jay Siesky made a motion to pay all listed and upcoming bills. Christopher Younkin seconded, and the motion carried.

Public Comment: Taylor Robbins stated that the Mountain Watershed Association was asking the township to submit a request to PENNDOT to place trail crossing signs along Route 31 where the Indian Creek Valley Trail begins. Dan Pribisco informed her that the Association's request had been sent to the township solicitor for review, as the township is concerned about possible liabilities.

Linda Brown asked when the sewage project contractors will be fixing yards. Andy Fedorko stated that there has been no talk to restoration yet. Dan Pribisco said that the township will ask about restoration efforts at the next construction progress meeting on April 28. Ms. Brown also asked when the pavement will be restored in front of her property, stating that she would like to know in advance because she is now entering her busy season, particularly Mother's Day weekend. Keith White and Andy Fedorko will both email contractors about this issue and pass the answer along to Ms. Brown. Linda Brown also asked about the proposed purchase of the Indian Creek Valley Water Authority by PA American Water, stating that the proposed 100% rate increase was unsustainable for businesses. Dan Pribisco stated that Donegal Township has no voice on the board of the water authority, as the board is filled by Saltlick and Springfield townships and Donegal Township is simply a customer. Ms. Brown was advised to contact the Water Authority and attend their board meeting.

New Business:

Jay Siesky made a motion to approve contractor pay application #5 from Hickes Associates in the amount of \$550,644.30. Dan Pribisco seconded, and the motion carried.

Christopher Younkin made a motion to submit reimbursement request #2 to the H2O grant in the amount of \$367,114.55 for the above pay application. Dan Pribisco seconded, and the motion carried.

Jay Siesky made a motion to submit reimbursement request #4 to the PENNVEST Construction Loan in the amount of \$183,563.97 to provide the match for the H2O request. Christopher Younkin seconded the motion, and the motion carried.

Dan Pribisco made a motion to submit reimbursement request #4 to the PENNVEST engineering loan in the amount of \$11,120.59 for engineering bills due during the last month. Jay Siesky seconded the motion, and the motion carried.

Jay Siesky made a motion to accept Amendment #5 to the EADS Group Engineering agreement in the amount of \$81,000 due to increased administrative costs and realignment changes. Dan Pribisco seconded, and the motion carried.

Christopher Younkin made a motion to advertise for bids for the Ridge Road paving project to be opened at the May 11th meeting. Dan Pribisco seconded, and the motion carried.

Old Business:

Work is underway on the new salt building funded by the LSA Category 4 grant.

Jay Siesky made a motion to adjourn, seconded by Christopher Younkin
