Meeting Brought to Order

Pledge of Allegiance

Supervisors Dan Pribisco, Jay Siesky, and Christopher Younkin and Township Secretary Keith White in attendance

Public in Attendance: Andy Fedorko, EADS Group; Jason McGinnis; Tom Stull; Debi Newquist

Jay Siesky made a motion to approve the minutes of the July meeting. Christopher Younkin seconded, and the motion carried.

Dan Pribisco made a motion to pay all listed and upcoming bills. Christopher Younkin seconded, and the motion carried.

Public Comment: Tom Stull stated that the supervisors should keep up the good work.

New Business:

Jay Siesky made a motion to apply to the Indian Creek Valley Water Authority for water service at the sewage treatment plant that is under construction, including payment of a \$8,610.00 tap in fee. Dan Pribisco seconded the motion, and the motion carried.

Dan Pribisco made a motion to approve Hickes Associates pay application #9 in the amount of \$1,108,126.75. Christopher Younkin seconded the motion, and the motion carried.

Jay Siesky made a motion to approve Ligonier Construction pay application #7 in the amount of \$81,082.56. Dan Pribisco seconded the motion, and the motion carried.

Christopher Younkin made a motion to submit reimbursement request #8 to the PENNVEST construction loan in the amount of \$1,189,310.77 to cover the approved pay requests. Dan Pribisco seconded the motion, and the motion carried.

Dan Pribisco made a motion to submit reimbursement request #8 to the PENNVEST engineering loan in the amount of \$30,367.23 to cover EADS invoices for the month. Jay Siesky seconded the motion, and the motion carried.

Andy Fedorko explained that Hickes Associates had to submit change order #2 because the wet well at the sewage plant needed to be moved in order to accommodate a larger footer. The wet well was originally placed in accordance with a preliminary design by the manufacturer, but a larger than expected footer caused pipes to be extended. Dan Pribisco made a motion to approve the change order in the amount of \$12,022.50. Christopher Younkin seconded the motion, and the motion carried.

Dan Pribisco stated that Steve Bizup has retired from garbage pickup and his company has been bought by Pro Disposal. Dan stated that he wanted to reiterate to residents that the township has no garbage contract and no say in garbage collection. Residents are free to hire the garbage contractor of their choice.

Old Business:

Dan Pribisco stated that the township road crew will be patch paving several roads in the coming weeks.

Dan also stated that the floor of the new salt building has been asphalted, and the township has been in contact with Log Cabin Fence to schedule completion of the building once the materials arrive.

Dan Pribisco spoke with representatives of the Westmoreland Conservation District about the Skyview Road Dirt and Gravel project. The Conservation District will be sending the first half of the grant money now that the out of right-of-way agreement is approved.

Jay Siesky made a motion to adjourn, seconded by Christopher Younkin
